

How to complete Hart's Housing Options Consultation response form in two minutes.

1. Go to <https://www.hart.gov.uk/local-plan-consultation-2016> . Scroll down the page and the response form is at the bottom.
2. Complete your **NAME** and your **POSTCODE**. **THIS IS ESSENTIAL** or will void your return.
3. Then the minimum you need complete is: Q4 and Q5.

Q4. Of the 3 possible approaches that could deliver new homes in Hart, which one should we prioritise to deliver the majority of our housing needs? *If you don't want a new settlement anywhere in Hart then we encourage you to make approach 3 your 3rd choice*

Please rank your choice in order of preference (1 = most preferred to 3 = least preferred). **You MUST click on one choice on each line. We recommend that you rank Approach 1 as 1, Approach 2 as 2 and Approach 3 as 3.**

Brownfield first followed by dispersal"* or *"Why not base the consultation on the new, lower SHMA?"*

Q5. If we need to combine approaches, which combinations do you prefer? *If you don't want a new settlement, then we encourage you to select 'Approach 4' as your first choice and we encourage that Approach 7 should be your second choice, with Approach 6 as your third choice and Approach 5 as your fourth choice.*
