

Proposed NEW Harlington Centre on Gurkha Square

But did you know.....

- Increased cost from £6m originally proposed to now over £10m: no plan as to how this will be funded apart from the precept of Fleet's taxpayers
- Loss each year of over £200,000 (this is in the business plan)
- Fleet taxpayers will be repaying for the new building for the next 40 years
- Existing building will be unused & closed
- New four storey building will take over most of Gurkha Square
- Gurkha Square will be LOST: no market, nowhere for community Fleet events, significantly less parking
- The Views are likely to be built on for the needed car parking: questions need to be asked about what the playground, skate park and remaining park will look like
