- 1. THE AREA OF SEARCH PLAN OMITS THE PART OF SHL133 (SWANS FARM, WINCHFIELD) LOCATED BETWEEN THE BASINGSTOKE CANAL AND ODIHAM COMMON. THIS LAND WOULD BE SUITABLE TO FORM PART OF A NEW SETTLEMENT PRINCIPALLY FOR OPEN SPACE USE.
- 2. THE PHRASE "PERMISSION WILL BE GRANTED" IS PRESUMPTIOUS PENDING COMPLETION OF MASTER PLAN, ENVIROMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND CONSULTATION.
- 3. THE DURATION OF THE PROPOSED MORATORIUM SHOULD BE TIME LIMITED TO ENABLE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT SUCH AS AT SHL 084 TO COME FORWARD IF THERE IS NO REASONABLE PROSPECT OF THE "NEW SETTLEMENT" BEING GRANTED PLANNING PERMISSION AHEAD OF A CUT OFF DATE.
